


What is Schoology?

- Learning Management System that allows teachers to...
 - Administer online curriculum materials.
 - Track and report student data and information.
 - Deliver online instruction within a blended classroom environment.
- Teachers focus on...
 - Increasing student engagement.
 - Creating deeper learning experiences.
 - Providing opportunities for communication and collaboration.
 - Assigning and collecting work electronically.
 - Fostering 21st Century Skills and Digital Citizenship.
- Engage with learning materials and the school community inside and outside of the classroom.
- Safe and monitored teacher/administrator/parent online environment.

What Parents Can See:

- The classes your child is enrolled in.
- The groups your child is a member of.
- Your child's upcoming assignments and due dates.
- School and class announcements and course updates.
- Calendar.
- Materials.
- Graded Schoology assignments.

What Parents Can Not See:

- Discussion posts from other students.
- Student roster.
- Comments or assignment submissions from other students.
- Full course content.



- Limited to only Red Clay students and teachers.
- Students can not create their own updates or pages.
- Student can only comment to discussions or topics teachers have posted in areas that teachers monitor.



- Anyone can join (under 13 years old with parent permission).
- Users get their own pages to post updates and pictures.



- Academic focus with monitored interaction opportunities to encourage collaboration, engagement, and cooperation.
- Teachers moderate all discussions and can control whether student comments must be approved before they appear in the course.
- All student interaction is logged... even students' deleted comments.



- Social focus.
- Users can post and delete anything.



- Teachers can enhance their classroom with digital tools in a safe, monitored environment.
- Safe, secure, ad-free, district only, teacher-monitored.









- Some teachers have blended learning units where content is delivered for enrichment, remediation, or self-paced lessons.

Content Delivery





- Tests and Quizzes with Immediate Feedback.
- Differentiated assessments given anonymously.
- Automatic grading for teachers.





- Teacher-to-Teacher collaboration, sharing of ideas, and resources throughout the district.
- Creating groups teams, clubs, etc.
- Collecting work and grading electronically.
- Integrating other web tools into instruction.
- Showcasing digital projects through portfolios.
- Personalize learning for students based on their needs.
- Supplementing curriculum materials with online instruction.
