AM/PM DROP OFF REMINDERS

As a friendly reminder, there are very strict Car Drop-Off/Pick-Up Protocols that were developed with the assistance of Red Clay District Representatives, DELDOT, New Castle County Crossing Guards and the Delaware State Police. When people don't follow the directions, others get upset. Let's not get the others upset. Remember, safety first!

DROP OFF LOCATIONS: There should NEVER be anyone dropping students off in front of the playground, in the bus lot area or on Skyline Drive - FOR ANY REASON. Any person dropping a student off at school in the morning should always get in car rider line. It moves quickly!

TRAFFIC FLOW: Our established traffic pattern requires all traffic to turn LEFT into the school property from the right hand shoulder (some exceptions happen when cars are teachers or substitutes). Cars will EXIT the property with a right hand turn. Again, this keeps traffic flowing and safe!

<u>CAR TAG NUMBERS</u>: Car rider number tags MUST be visible at all times on property. This allows us to get your student to your car quicker! If you do NOT have a SCHOOL issued number card, please go to office and get one OR contact us and we will send them home with your child. As this is a major safety protocol, we will no longer be accepting verbal or hand written numbers at this point in the year.

PLEASE be patient and realize none of our teachers are expert traffic controllers- we do our best each and every day to get your child safely and quickly to your car. Please help us by following ALL of the rules we have posted for a quick and safe car rider line!
