From Nurse Ewing - Lyme Disease Season

In 2017, there were 608 cases of Lyme disease that were treated in the state of Delaware. As the weather gets warmer and we are spending more time outdoors, it is important to recognize the risk and symptoms of Lyme disease and other tick-borne illnesses. Lyme disease is caused by the bacteria, Borrelia burgdorferi, and is transmitted to animals and humans through the bite of an infected black-legged or deer tick. Immature ticks are tiny and can be difficult to see which can increase the possibility of undetected tick exposures. Over the next week, our students will be learning how to "BLAST" Lyme disease. They will be hearing a presentation given by the Delaware Department of Health about how to prevent and recognize Lyme disease and other tick-borne illnesses.
