CLASS DUES & SCHOOL OBLIGATIONS:

Class dues are paid to senior class adviser.

School obligations handled by Mrs. Wirt in the main office.

Class dues should be paid each year. If you have not paid in the past you would now owe \$50.00 total. It does not need to be paid all at once. You only pay for the years you have attended A.I..

All dues must be paid prior to attending prom or receiving your diploma.

Any school obligations must also be cleared before attending prom or receiving your diploma.
