**SKYLINE MIDDLE SCHOOL CELL PHONE UTILIZATION POLICY**  
**2022 – 2023**

- Cell phones may be used to listen to music during LUNCH ONLY: For safety purposes, during allowable use time (LUNCH) students may only use one ear bud.
- Wireless Ear Buds are not to be worn with the exception of the lunch period.
- Large noise cancelling head phones will not be permitted.
- Students will not be permitted to charge their phone during the school day this is inclusive of lunch.
- Cell phones may not be used in the hallways during transition and/or academic time, in classrooms, or during assemblies.
- Cell phones will be required to remain on silent mode during all times.
- Cell phone use is not permitted in areas where privacy is expected, such as restrooms, locker rooms.
- The use of videotaping, audio recording and photographing is not permitted without the approval of any and all parties involved.
- Students must turn off and put away a cell phone when requested by a staff member at any time.
- For safety purposes, during school emergency's and crisis situations cell phone use will not be permitted.
- Skyline Administration is requesting that the "Air-Drop" function on the phone is turned off during the instructional day. (7:50 a.m. - 2:45p.m.)
- Parent(s)/Guardian(s): Please contact the Skyline Main Office if there is a need to contact your student during the instructional day. (302-454-3410)

~Violations to the Cell Phone Policy will be handled on an individual basis by a member of the Skyline Administrative Team.

The student must secure his/her device at all times and never leave it unattended. Students should guard against theft as they would in any public building or area. Students should keep the devices on their person or locked away. School personnel and/or administrators are not responsible for the loss or damage of any cell phone, accessories, and/ or device brought on school property.
