# Locker/Locker Time

The purpose of this document is to provide protocols and expectations for Skyline classroom teachers to help reduce to the traffic flow and number of students within the hallways. Please read below.

### Morning Arrival:

- Students will immediately report to their advisory classes after they pick up their breakfast. No students will be permitted to utilize their lockers upon entering the building and during arrival.
- Due to a possible earlier arrival time, some students may have had the opportunity to eat in the cafeteria. Those students will also report directly to their homeroom and may not utilize their lockers.
- Students will report to their homerooms and only use their lockers at their designated times. In order to adhere to social distancing guidelines, teachers are to create an internal classroom schedule for students to use their lockers. No more than 5 students may leave the classroom at a time.
  - Cohort A: 8:02-8:15
  - Cohort B: 8:20-8:35

### Lunch Time:

- Students who need to get their lunch from their locker may do so during the last ten minutes of the academic class preceding their time.
- Teachers should limit the number of students leaving the classroom to get their lunch to two students at a time.
- All students must return to their academic classroom to walk down to the cafeteria escorted by their teacher. <u>No students report directly to cafeteria from their classroom without a teacher</u>.

#### Dismissal:

 Students are to be released from their academic classrooms to get their belongings as their bus number is called. The office will limit the number of buses being simultaneously called.
\*\*Students enrolled in AVID, Art, Music, Phys. Ed and/or Health students may bring their belongings with them to class. This will help to expedite the process of dismissal.
