Asynchronous Wednesday's

All Richey students (AE, remote and face-to-face students) will be engaged in asynchronous learning every Wednesday. Students should be engaged in small groups (zoom), one-on-one with the teacher (zoom), and or independent work/activities as determined by the teacher.

Student Materials

Students should bring the learning materials and Chromebooks back to school on Monday, January 11th unless instructed by the homeroom teacher.

Teachers will share specifics if necessary, regarding other materials that should accompany students on Monday.

Chromebooks

All students in grades K-5 should bring the Chromebooks home nightly and are expected to bring them back to school each day fully charged. We ask that you help your child charge the Chromebook each night and safely pack the Chromebook in their book bag each morning. This will allow students to access technology both at home and school and allow for access during asynchronous Wednesdays.

On-Campus students who are car riders/walkers

Arrival Car Riders/Walkers-The school doors will open at 8:50 am. Please do not let your children gather outside the main doors prior to 8:50 am. Car rider students can arrive between 8:50-9:10. If you are first in the car rider line in the AM, please pull all the way up to the first orange cone.

Dismissal Car Riders-If your child is a car rider, please help your child remember their car rider number. Make sure to have your car rider placard the front window each afternoon during pick-up. We will begin the dismissal process early (3:30 pm) for walkers and car riders until they are reacclimated to the process. Thank you in advance for your patience and flexibility.

Placards will be needed to pick up car riders and walkers.

School Hours

School hours are 8:50-3:50. Students can arrive between 8:50-9:10. The front doors will open at 8:50 am. Please do not drop your child off prior to 8:50. We do not want large groups of students waiting outside the school doors unattended.

Breakfast/Lunch

Richey will continue to offer free grab and go breakfast for every student. Students are permitted to eat breakfast at home if they prefer.

Free lunch will be provided for every Richey student. Students are permitted to bring a packed lunch if they prefer.

Third Marking Period

A message from Superintendent Green:

"The third marking period will begin on February 1, 2021, and students will continue in Phase 2 of our phased reopening plan. Students will continue with whichever option they selected in the fall—Red Clay Online or Red Clay on Campus.
