RED CLAY CONSOLIDATED SCHOOL DISTRICT RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE USE OF SCHOOL SWIMMING POOLS

- 1. Swimming is allowed only when a lifeguard is on duty.
- 2. Horseplay (running, splashing, shoving, or dunking) is not allowed.
- 3. Diving is allowed only in designated areas.
- 4. Glass containers are not allowed in the facility.
- 5. Throwing objects, such as ball, are not allowed except in supervised situations.
- 6. Swimming is not allowed in the diving area when diving is taking place.
- 7. Diving or jumping from the side of the pool into the diving area is not allowed.
- 8. Non-swimmers and children under the age of 12 must be supervised by an adult.
- 9. Patrons who wish to enter deep water may be required to demonstrate their swimming ability.
- 10. Instructions by lifeguards must be obeyed at all times.
