ADMINISTRATIVE MEMORANDUM

SCHOOL DANCES | 8024.1

The district recognizes the importance of student safety at social events. The purpose of this administrative memorandum is to establish procedures regarding student attendance at proms and other school dances. Additional restrictions may be put into place on a school-by-school basis at the discretion of the building principal.

High School Dances/Proms

- 1. To attend a Red Clay high school dance or prom, the attendee must be 20 years old or younger on the day of the dance and must be at least in the ninth grade.
- 2. No one is permitted to attend as a guest if they are working in Red Clay in any capacity (including volunteer coaches, etc.).
- 3. The Student Code of Conduct is in effect for all students who attend social gatherings governed by schools. [5]

Middle School Dances

- 1. To attend a Red Clay middle school dance, the attendee must be 16 years old or younger on the day of the dance and must be at least in the sixth grade.
- 2. The Student Code of Conduct is in effect for all students who attend social gatherings governed by schools.
