UPDATES & REMINDERS

SAFETY & SECURITY

As part of our comprehensive safety and security program, we want all families to know about protocols for visitors and safety drills. All Red Clay schools require visitors to have photo identification, which will be held in the Main Office while the visitor remains in the school. If you are interested in volunteering in your child's classroom or on a field trip, please complete the required Volunteer Clearance form (attached). A new form must be filled out every year.

All Red Clay schools will hold 9 fire drills and 3 lockdown drills per school year. Teachers have already started reviewing how to safely exit the building during fire drills. Each classroom has an exit plan and a designated "safe" area on the playground. We follow strict protocols to ensure all students are accounted for. During our lockdown drills, students will remain in their classrooms in a designated area and all hallways, bathrooms and offices are checked to ensure student safety.

Today, we held our first lockdown safety drill. An announcement was made that this was a "practice safety drill" and students remained in their classrooms with their teachers. Classroom doors were checked to ensure they were in the locked position with door windows covered while students remained quiet to listen for directions from their teachers. Our drill lasted approximately 3 minutes, at which time another announcement was made that the drill was over and regular routines resumed. I want to thank our amazing staff for preparing our students for all of the safety drills we are required to have as a public school.

LEADER IN MIE

Our first week of Habit Heroes was a HUGE SUCCESS!!! These students will be recognized at Habit Hero Assemblies throughout the school year. Parents will be notified when their child is a Habit Hero! Congratulations to our BE PROACTIVE Habit Heroes!!

ARRIVAL/DISMISSAL

Friendly reminders: Our instructional day begins at 9:05am. Students purchasing breakfast have the opportunity to "Grab and Go" from the café beginning at 8:50 in order to arrive in their classrooms at 9:00am. All remaining students will be permitted into the building at 8:55am. Our instructional day ends at 3:45pm. Early dismissals will only be permitted **before 3:15pm**. Our walker and car rider dismissal will begin at 3:50pm. Our buses will depart at 4:05pm. All students are to be picked up by 4:05pm. We do not have staff available to supervise children after that time.

*No cars are permitted to park in the neighborhood OR on Skyline Drive during arrival/dismissal times. Students should either walk with guidance from the crossing guards, dropped off by the bus in front of the school or dropped off by a car following the car line protocol.

CAR LINE

Morning— Cars should enter the Linden Hill parking lot off of Skyline Drive at the direction of the Crossing Guard. Cars will be directed to loop around by the recess lot and pull to the available slots, 1-12. Students should exit their vehicle and immediately go to the sidewalk to be watched carefully by staff members. In an effort for a safer transition, students should exit vehicles on the passenger side/sidewalk side. *All cars should remain in a line/order and stay in that order as they exit, which will allow students to safely exit their cars to the sidewalk. No passing should occur. Remember, we are dealing with children – safety first! (These procedures are the same as last school year, with the small change of staff not opening car doors during arrival.)

Afternoon – Cars should only enter the Linden Hill parking lot off of Skyline Drive at the direction of the Crossing Guard. Cars will form lines from the front cone to the last cone (12 cars per line). Once the closest line of cars is filled, we will fill the subsequent rows. **Staff members will load cars in groups of 12 (cones 1-12).** Students will be waiting for their vehicle as their car pulls up.

- All vehicles MUST REMAIN IN THE ORDER OF THEIR ARRIVAL in order to navigate this process.
- All vehicles MUST HAVE THEIR CAR TAG # DISPLAYED ON THEIR REAR VIEW MIRROR in order for staff to correctly identify which students are assigned to which car.
- Once students are safely placed in their vehicle, all cars MUST FOLLOW IN ORDER AS THEY EXIT TO SKYLINE DRIVE. No vehicles are permitted to pass on the left, as this would put our children in unnecessary danger.
- Drivers should remain in their cars at all times. Staff will escort students to their
- Drivers are encouraged to put their cars in "Park" to avoid rolling back/forward.

PLAYGROUND SAFETY

In order to ensure the safety of our students during unstructured play time, there are some guidelines that all Linden Hill students must comply with. Additionally, LHE is not responsible for any lost/stolen/damaged items that are brought from home.

Items that are NOT permitted at school:

- ➤ Leather footballs
- ➤ Hard bats (including baseball, cricket)
- Pokémon cards
- ➤ Electronic equipment (tablets, iPod, phones)

BEFORE/AFTER SCHOOL ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES

If you signed your child up for an after school program, it is your responsibility to communicate with their teacher about any changes in their dismissal.

*All after school program coordinators will bring the children out to the main entrance (outside) when their program ends. No one is permitted to enter the building. This is a safety/security issue, as no one will be in the office to monitor who enters/exits and NO doors should ever be propped open.

RED CLAY CAFÉ - FREE/REDUCED LUNCH

Families who may be eligible for free or reduced priced meals can apply by completing the **Meal Benefit Form** as soon as possible and returning it to your child's school. **Only complete one application per family must be completed EACH school year**. The information provided on the MBF will be used to determine or prove your child's eligibility for free or reduced-priced meals. This information may also be used for other state or federally funded school benefits. Children from households that meet Federal Income Guidelines who are eligible for reduced priced meals will not be charged the reduced price meal fee as a new department policy.

FOOD BANK OF DE – BACK PACK PROGRAM

Linden Hill has partnered with the Food Bank of Delaware to implement their Children's Nutrition Program for families in need of support. Participants in the "Back-Pack" program are given a package of food to take home for the weekend. Participation in this program does not require income verification or disclosure of private information.

The Food Bank will deliver a package to school each week. The bag provides 2 days' worth of shelf-stable, nutritious, child-friendly meals and a snack. Packages will be discretely distributed to students before they leave for the school day. Bags need not be returned.
