

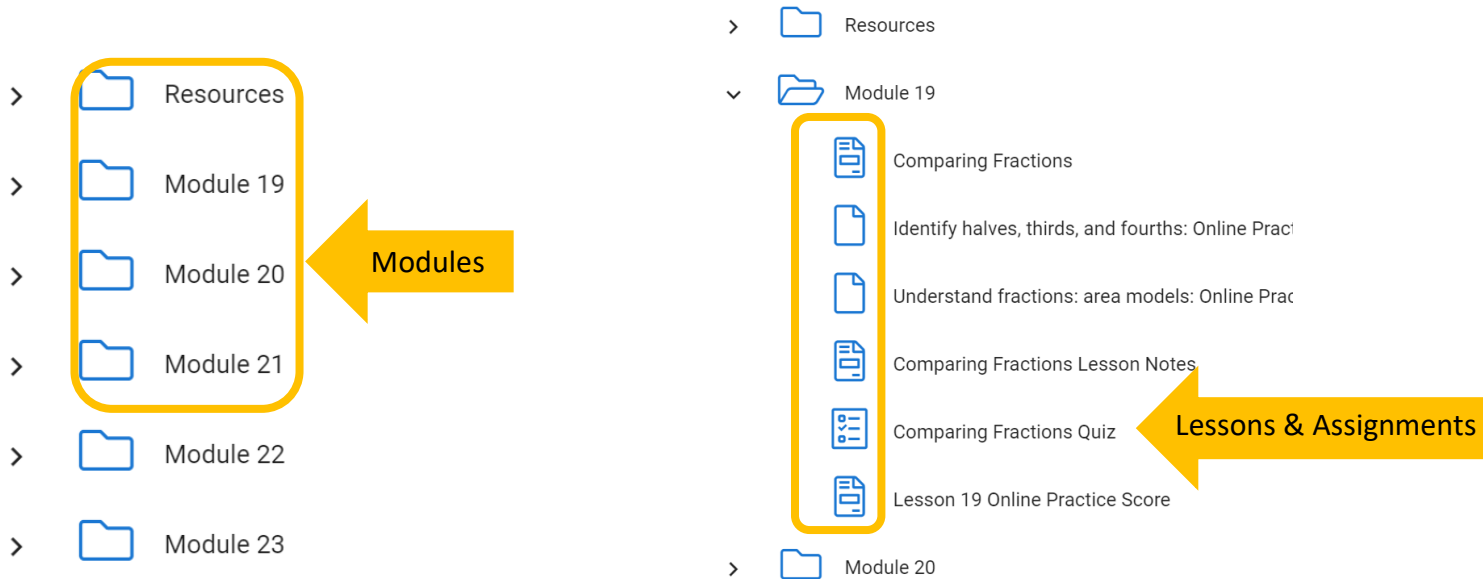
Next, you will see your student's home page, which is a quick overview of the most important information about their courses. It's divided into several parts:

5. Activity Stream



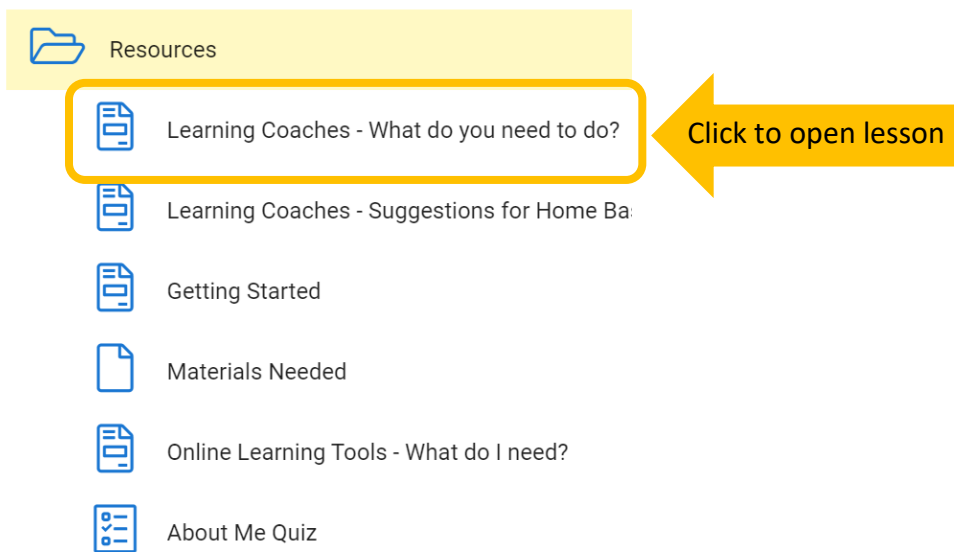

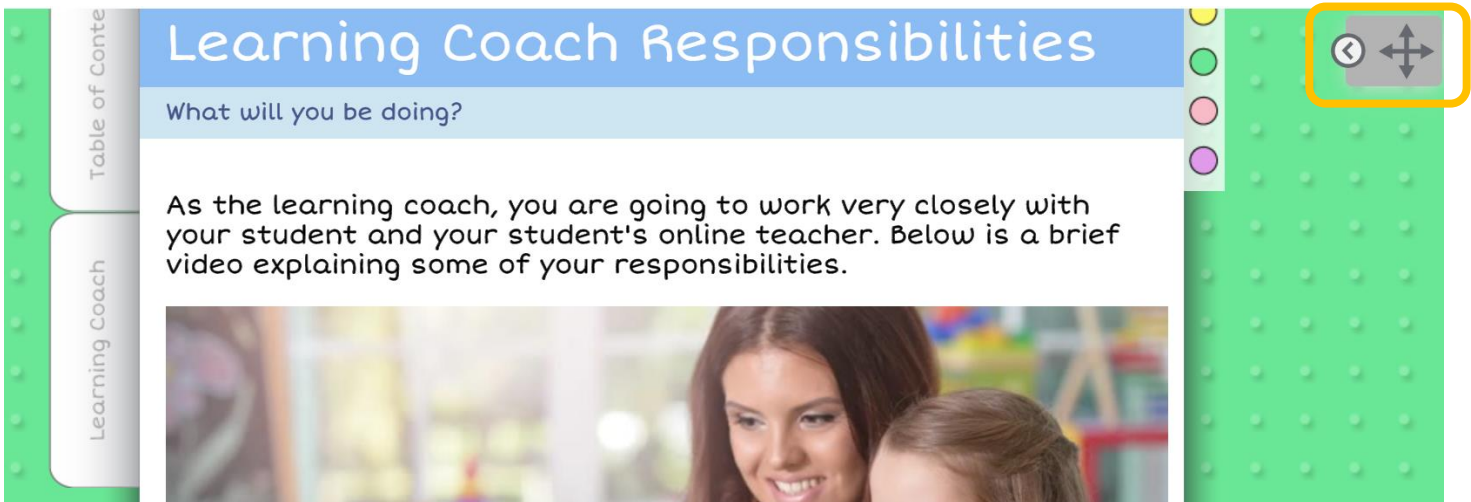

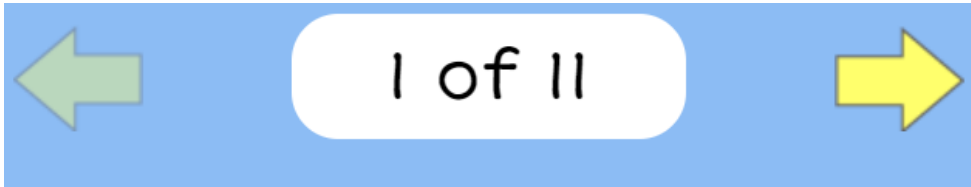
**Together with their guardian or Learning Coach they should go through Resources module to learn how to get started.**
