



Click on the specific course card to get started in observing that course.



Students Read through lessons and complete videos and activities throughout.



Students will use arrows to click through lesson pages.

As they progress through content, they will click "Mark Activity Complete" when finished with their lesson and then click "Next Activity" to go to the next lesson.



When students see these buttons, they can click to open activities. Students may print these or they may have been provided to your student in a workbook or print out from your school.

Their teachers will communicate with them on submitting their assignments and meeting with them.

Observers can check on the student's progress and click on the "bar graph" grades images in the upper right corner of the course. This will show specific grades on assignments submitted.
