Please note the following dates, events, and operating procedures that will take place as the year begins.

- **August 20th:** "Buzzing to Kindergarten" from 4:00 – 6:00 p.m.—Orientation for you and your KN child.
- **August 22nd:** "Buzzing into Lewis Classrooms" aka Lewis 'Block Party' from 4:00 – 6:00 p.m.—Visit your classroom and get information regarding PTA, uniforms, before & after school care, etc.
- **August 26th:** First day of school for all 1st – 5th grade students and *some* Kindergarten students.
- **Please note our arrival and dismissal times:**
 - o Front doors open for students daily at **8:45 a.m.**
 - o Cafeteria doors open daily at **8:35 a.m.** Grab and Go breakfast is served for all students at **8:35 a.m.** **Kindergarten and 1st grade students will eat in the cafeteria. All other students will eat in their classrooms.** Breakfast & Lunch are provided to all students at no cost. Snacks have a nominal fee.
 - o **Please make sure students arrive on time daily by 8:55 a.m.**
 - o Parents of car riders should use the entrance on 10th Street. **To ensure the safety of your child, do not drop off any student prior to 8:35 a.m.** as supervision is not available until 8:35 a.m.
 - o Dismissal is at 3:50 p.m. **To eliminate classroom disruptions, early dismissals between 3:15 and 3:50 p.m. will not be permitted unless previously requested in writing.**
- ***Kindergarten Students** will have staggered start dates.*
 - o **Kindergarten students will only attend two days of classes during the first week. Some will attend 8/26 and 8/27; others will be 8/28 and 8/29. Letters will soon be sent home stating which two days your kindergarten child will attend. If you have not received this letter by August 21, please call the school office.**
 - o ALL kindergarten students will attend daily starting Tuesday, September 3.
 - o Kindergarten walkers and car riders are dismissed from the 10th Street doors.
- Families are welcome to walk children to the front door, but students need to go to their classrooms unaccompanied.
- **Pre-K first day of school:** September 3.
 - o Please remember there is no transportation for Pre-K students.
 - o Pre-K daily hours are 8:50 a.m. - 3:50 p.m. There is no before and after school care for Pre-K students.
- **September 26:** Back to School Open House: Pre-K-5th Grade - 6:00-8:00 p.m.

Additional Information:

- **Before & After Care (KN-5):** The Latin American Community Center (LACC) offers before and after childcare. You can register by calling 302-655-7338 or obtaining information in our main office.
- **School Uniforms (KN-5):** Students are required to wear a uniform [yellow shirt, dark blue pants or skirt]. Please make sure you adhere to the policy. The policy has been revised and updated. If you need more information, please contact our main office.
- **Birthdays:** In accordance with the District's Health and Wellness Policy, birthdays will not be celebrated *with food*. Please do not send in treats with your child, as they will not be distributed. Birthdays will be acknowledged on the morning announcements and with a ribbon and a pencil from the Principal.
