

TB (tuberculosis)-Endemic Countries

The list below is based on data from the World Health Organization, 2012. *The listed countries had a TB case rate of 20/100K or more within the past ten years.* US Customs requires those emigrating to provide a Tuberculin Skin Test (TST) or TB Blood Test (IGRA). These countries are considered high-risk for exposure to TB. Tuberculin skin testing is required for those living in, traveling to, or living with someone from a high-risk country for greater than one month.
