What is PBS?

Positive Behavior Support or PBS is a school-wide behavior management system that establishes clear and consistent expectations and procedures aimed at developing positive behavior in students.

The program consists of 4 key components:

- Program Development and Evaluation
- School-wide and Classroom Systems
- Correcting Problem Behaviors
- Developing Self-Discipline

What are Skyline Middle School’s school-wide behavior expectations?

The PAWS Pride or PAWS are the school-wide behavior expectations that are taught and reinforced in all areas of the school including the bus.



“PAWS Pride”

- P- Person/Self
- A- Action Towards Others
- W- Work in Academics
- S- School and Community

What is the Skyline Middle School school-wide behavior support matrix?

The school-wide behavior matrix provides operational definitions for each of the four school-wide behavior expectations including the bus (see attached).

How are students positively reinforced for exhibiting the school-wide behavior expectations?

Skyline Middle School uses a ticket system to positively reinforce students. PAWS Pride tickets are given to students when they exhibit the school-wide behavior expectations and those tickets can be cashed in for various classroom-based and school-wide incentives.
