- Dental sealants applications to protect white coating-molars and prevent cavities
- Case management to discuss child's dental needs and identify dental resources

## Can my child receive dental care and how do I sign up?

- Child must be a student at the school
- Child must be insured by Delaware Medicaid, CHIP, or have no dental insurance
- Child has not had a dental cleaning in the past seven months

Dental sealants are thin, white coatings painted on the chewing surfaces of the back teeth (molars) that can prevent cavities for many years.
