


Creating a SBAC Report to see Projected 2020 Student Targets



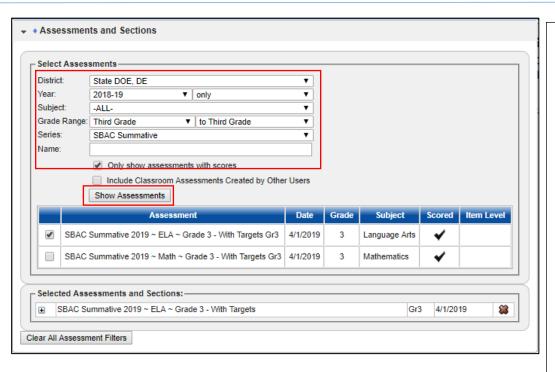
1. Click on the Reports Icon at the top of

the page

- 2. Click "Reports"
- 3. Click "PerformanceTRACKER"
- 4. Select "Assessment Scores"

- 5. Click "Filters"
- 6. Click "Assessments and Sections"
- 7. Use the following filters:

DISTRICT: Defaults to your district

Year: 2018-2019

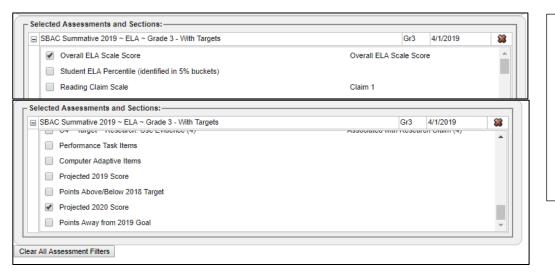
Grade Range: Use the grade that the student was in at the time they took

the SBAC in Spring 2019

Series: SBAC Summative

- 8. Click "Show Assessments"
- 9. Assessments will show up below. Select "SBAC Summative 2019..." by clicking on the box to the left of the assessment name.

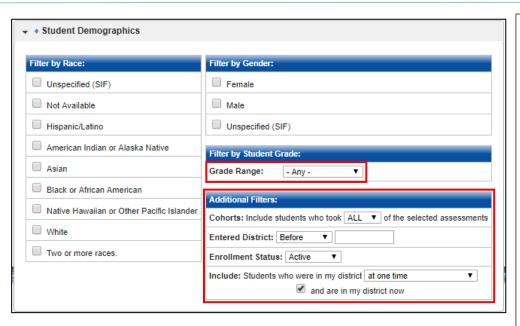
NOTE: ELA and Math will show up, be sure to select the correct one.

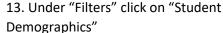


- 10. Under "Selected Assessments and Sections" the assessment name will appear.
- 11. Click on the "+" to the left of the name to see the sections
- 12. Select "Overrall ELA Scale Score" and "Projected 2020 Score"

14. Under the "Additional Filters" section use the following filters:

Cohorts: Include students who took <u>ALL</u> of the selected assessments

Entered District: (leave as default)

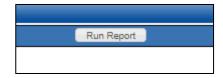
Enrollment Status: Active

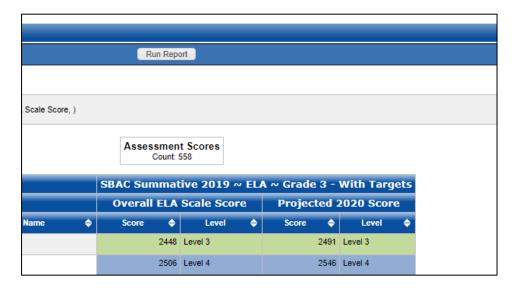
Include: Students who were in my

15. Check "and are in my district now"

16. Click "Run Report" (located in the middle of the header of the report)





Your report should look like the image to the left. Your student names will appear on the left hand side. You will only see students that you have access to, so for a teacher you will only see your class(es). For an administrator, you will see the entire grade level that you selected in the filter.
