- 2. ESSER 2 Progress:
 - ESSER 2 is in its punch list stage.
 - With the funding, the district replaced three school roofs, chillers, and boilers in 9 schools, along with other HVAC work totaling \$17.9 million.
- 3. Drinking Water Testing:
 - Red Clay has one drinking source undergoing retesting for elevated lead levels.
 The district will request a proposal from outside vendors to test the whole district once a year.
- 4. Major Cap Referendum Review:
 - The district has received the RFPs for design firms, and we plan to evaluate them in the coming weeks
 - Also, the order of the projects was reviewed
- 5. Heritage Loop Road Bids:
 - Is being used by the school (contractor still has final work to complete)
