

Policy Statement

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Summer Programs	Instruction Policy 7008
 Summer programs may be provided for students in grades K-12 to provide opportunities for enrichment and intervention and for students in grades 9-12 to provide opportunities for credit recovery. 	
 Summer programs shall be comparable in quality to programs offered during the regular school year. 	
 Intervention/Acceleration courses at the elementary levels 	
and make-up and review courses at the secondary levels shall provide opportunities for students to qualify for promotion and/or credits in subjects where previous work has not met standards.	
 Summer programs shall be financed by fees, by the 	
government or outside agencies, or by financing determined by the Board.	
 Fees charged to resident and non-resident students shall be subject to Board approval. 	
 Summer curriculum shall be established to meet student 	
needs in accordance with state regulations.	
 The District has the right to cancel announced summer 	
courses for which there is insufficient enrollment and to refund fees.	
• The District has the right to dismiss a student for disciplinary reasons with no refund of fees.	
 Students attending summer courses shall receive grades for 	
work completed. Grading shall be in accordance with established guidelines used during the regular school year.	

• The Superintendent shall establish procedures for recording summer program grades on student records.

Responsibility	The Superintendent shall be responsible for compliance.
