



RCCSD Chromebook Accidental Protection Plan

Red Clay Consolidated School District recognizes that with the implementation of the 1:1 Chromebook Initiative there is a need to protect the investment for the district, as well as the student and parent/guardian.

Red Clay Consolidated School District will be the sole provider of the Accidental Protection Plan. Under this plan, the Chromebooks are protected against accidental damage, theft or loss due to an act of nature. In cases of theft, vandalism, or other criminal acts, a police report, or in the case of fire, a fire report must be filed by the parent or guardian. A copy of this report must be submitted to school administration before the Chromebook can be repaired or replaced. A student making a false report will be subject to disciplinary action.

The Accidental Protection Plan does not cover for loss of the Chromebook and/or its accessories, cosmetic damage, or damages caused by intentional misuse and abuse. Administration will assess the Chromebook damage and repair or replace the device if the damage is determined to be accidental. Parents or guardians may be charged for full replacement cost of a device that has been lost or damaged due to intentional misuse or abuse. The Accidental Protection Plan cost and coverage is on the Declarations page as part of this document.

There will be no deductible charged on the first claim. The second claim, however, and each subsequent claim will be assessed an incremental deductible. The claim deductibles are listed below. If a student withdraws from Red Clay Consolidated School District and then re-enrolls the coverage purchased at the student's initial registration will be reinstated along with the number of claims made prior to withdrawal. If parents or guardians choose not to enroll in the Accidental Protection Plan their student's Chromebook must remain in school and checked out and checked in at the beginning and end of each school day. The student's Google Drive is accessible from any electronic device with Internet connection.

The student and parent or guardian will be responsible for the full amount of the repair and/or replacement.</p> <p><u>Consumables:</u> Including but not limited to the charger and software.</p> <p><u>Cosmetic damage</u> that does not affect the functionality of the device. This includes but is not limited to scratches, dents, and broken plastic ports or port covers.</p> <p><u>“Jailbreaking”</u> or otherwise voiding the manufacturer’s warranty by altering the software.</p> <p><i>Red Clay Consolidated School District is not liable for the loss, damage, or costs arising from the unauthorized use of the school issued device.</i></p>
