Abstract:

The YTD Total Expenditures and Encumbrances Report for fiscal year 2008 tracks district costs by object code and is used by the State of Delaware's accounting system to identify line item expenses and encumbrances. An encumbrance is an accounting procedure that sets aside available funds for commitments related to unperformed contracts for goods and services, to ensure the availability of funds when payment is requested. This report includes prior year appropriations that were expended in the 2008 fiscal year. An appropriation is an authorization granted by the legislative body to make expenditures and to incur obligations for specific purposes. An appropriation is usually limited in amount and in the time during which it may be expended.

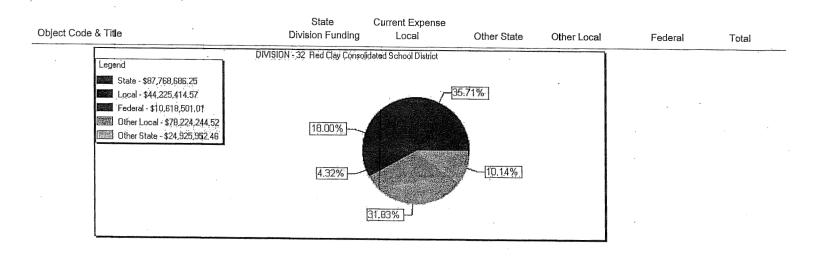

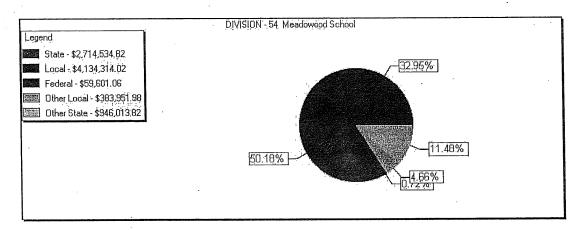

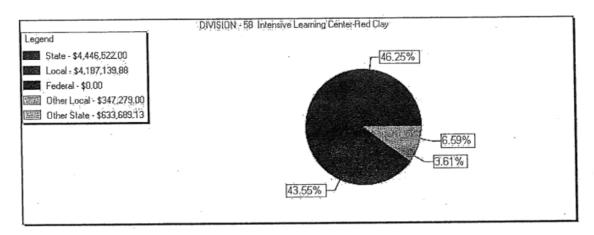
