

## Public Session to be Held on Superintendent Search

The Red Clay Consolidated School District Board of Education will hold in public session a portion of the meeting scheduled Aug. 28, 2018 on a search to replace outgoing Superintendent Merv Daugherty.

While it was originally announced that the meeting would be a closed, executive session, upon clarification and advice from the district's attorney, it was learned that aspects of the search may be discussed publicly at this time.

Items to be discussed include the process, desired qualifications for a superintendent, the timing of the process and the district's priorities, according to Catherine Thompson, president of the school board.

"We want the public to be involved in this important decision for the future of the district," she said. "The board will look for ways to bring the public into the discussion in meaningful ways."

The meeting will be held at 5:30 p.m. in the boardroom at district offices, 1502 Spruce Ave., Wilmington. First on the agenda is a discussion of district finances.

Superintendent Daugherty announced last week that he would be leaving the district in November to lead Chesterfield County Public Schools in Virginia.
