Update	CN was submitted to DOE with the \$200M in most critical capital improvements identified in the facilities assessment. DOE notified us that they were unable to approve the CN due to funding. They are focused on completing existing projects and projects related to additional capacity (student growth).

Update	Marcin reviewed the most recent quarterly report. It showed that we were tracking significantly behind in the energy savings. The first quarter of the year is typically one where we don't meet our savings target and it was compounded this year by a large number of summer school programs and the ongoing COVID protocols which call for the HVAC systems to run for extended periods of time and to bring in additional outside air.
